• **Class Dojo:** Please register for ClassDojo. This is a free communication tool we use schoolwide to keep our parents informed of school happenings. It is also a wonderful way to stay in constant communication with your child's teacher as well. I have already begun posting messages on the school story to keep parents updated. Please make sure you are checking the class story and school story daily so you do not miss any pertinent information.

 - Attendance is required in accordance with Georgia state laws. The attendance protocol will be strictly followed for the 2023-2024 school term.
 - Breakfast: 7:00 7:30
 - Early Release: 11:00am 1:45pm. For security reasons, we do not honor early checkouts after 1:45 during dismissal preparations.
 - All students not participating in afterschool activities or Owls Nest must be off campus by 2:45pm.

- Uniform Colors: navy or khaki bottoms, navy/light blue/white/yellow tops Please help us enforce the uniform that was selected several years ago by our community. Our students receive ClassDojo points for being in uniform and classes highlighted. We do not want any of our students to miss out!
- **Visitors:** We appreciate each of our volunteers and community partners. We welcome parents/guardians back into our building for volunteer opportunities.
